

## CHOUFTOUHONNA, Tunis International Feminist Art Festival: Call for Participation

The Feminist Tunis CHOUFTOUHONNA festival is honored, for its first edition to invite any amateur of art, all of you, all people who identify as female, to express her creativity in the fields of cinema, fine arts (painting, sculpture, drawing, engraving), dance, poetry, writing, music (instrumental, electronic, and vocals), photography, theater, performance art and all.

This first edition will be under the subject: "Five minutes after you birth, they will decide your name, your nationality, your religion, your sexuality and your community ... and you'll spend your whole life fighting for things you ' have not chosen and defend stupidly. "

All entries must be submitted before Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at noon (12.00).

The festival jury will be composed of four professional women artists. The exhibition, screenings and performances of various works and projects and the awards ceremony will take place Sunday, May 17, 2015 from 13h to 20h.

On the occasion of this ceremony, four prizes will be awarded:

- Grand Jury Prize
- Second Prize of the Jury
- Audience Award
- Diaspora Prize

The first three prizes will be endowed with a sum of money and a trophy.

The diaspora prizes shall consist of a trophy.

### Logistic Information::

All participants living in Tunisia but not in Tunis the capital city, will be reimbursed for their transportation expenses on presentation of a ticket or receipt bus, or train.

### Regarding the works:

For video or audio performance (theater, music, dance, reading included):

- Time: 1 to 10 minutes / up to 13 minutes for the cinema
- Formats to send JPEG, PSD, MP4, MP3, AUDIO, TEXT

For performance 2 or 3 dimensions (photography, fine arts)

- Numbers: 3 per participant
- Formats: JPEG, PSD, and all materials for sculpture

The festival organization will be responsible for printing photographs and images without censorship.
